SCOPE OF WORK

It is understood that the Franklin Lakes Public Schools is interested in having a demographic study prepared. We use as a base for the demographic study the cohort survival method of population projection. This method is standard and is fully acceptable by the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE). These base projections are modified by the impact of planned and approved residential development, changes in the academic program, and any other factor that would have an impact on the number of students in the district.

We use the enrollment figures as of each October 15th from NJSMART enrollments reported by the district to NJDOE. Birth figures are obtained from the New Jersey Department of Health. Planned, approved, and pending residential development data are obtained from the local Planning Board.

Whitehall's typical demographic study consists of a set of easy to understand tables and an accompanying narrative. Each district has its own characteristics, therefore, each report is different to a great extent. The general explanations may remain the same. Shown below is a typical synopsis of the tables.

DECENNIAL POPULATION - tabulates the decennial population of the municipality since 1930. An analysis is contained in the narrative.

TABLE 1 is the pre-school data, both the "universe" and actual, as required by the NJDOE.

TABLE 2 is the district's enrollment history wherein the survival ratios are developed. This table accommodates the NJDOE electronic forms and can be used with ease.

TABLE 3 projects the student enrollment for the next five years and also follows the general format of the NJDOE worksheets. It is the main table and is designed to be used in conferences and meetings. It allows the participant to be able to refer to one page rather than searching through a document for more information. The back-up for Table 3 entries are found in the other tables. All calculations are carried to eight or more decimal places. Since there cannot be fractions of a student, the district totals may vary by one or two students if added manually.

Table 3 also displays the live births attributed to the municipality for the five years prior to the kindergarten year shown. A dashed boxed area to the lower left of the table is an area of low confidence in that these children have either not been born or reported. By convention these births may be shown as a regression, an average of the last eight year's births or the last known birth figure.

A line labeled "Net Development Impact" is used when there is a residential development impact in the district. All the residential developments are listed in Table 4. Since there is no way to accurately determine the date of occupancy of these developments, they are listed as an aggregated line item and added to the final year's projected enrollment.

TABLE 4 shows all the planned, approved and proposed residential developments within Franklin Lakes and their individual impact. Since each development is a relatively small sample, the aggregate anticipated student population is used to determine the by grade impact used in Table 3.

TABLE 5 is the student enrollment projection by grade, by school, five years hence.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT
