14. **REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS**

Vision Statement:

In pursuit of our district's vision to build a learning environment where all children and adults take ownership to become imaginative, reflective, information age explorers and contributors to society, by developing in students a life-long commitment to learning, a sense of personal and social responsibility, healthy selfesteem, and a respect and appreciation of diversity, I offer the following update on our progress toward District Goals.

Our first goal speaks to the importance of Student Achievement, assessment and program evaluation.

- On Friday, February 20th, I had the privilege of being invited to the Read Across America celebration at High Mountain Road School. I would like to thank Mrs. Bajzath, her staff and students for allowing me to be part of this very special event. Upper grade students performed a skit that was reflective of both their love of reading and a heartfelt plea to the audience to support their book drive. The drive is intended to bring donated books to children who do not have books of their own to read at home. After the performance, students from each class escorted one of the special guest readers to their classroom. Mr. Solokas and I, who were among those guest readers, read to second grade classes, where we not only shared a great piece of children's literature, but also spent time answering student's questions. Today, I received a thank you note from each child in the class I spent time with. What a wonderful way to spend a morning. I truly enjoy opportunities to spend time with teachers and students.
- Today I conducted the last of four Coffee Chats, held during the month of February at each of our schools. These were casual, open forum events during which parents engaged in dialogue with me as well as with other members of the administrative team, and in some cases members of the Board as well. Thank you to Mrs. McGowan and Mrs. Veliky for attending. The upcoming PARCC administration, school safety, curriculum, parent workshops, and homework were some of the topics discussed as these events. I want to thank district and building administrators for joining me and for adding to the depth of these conversations. I hope parents who were able to attend found these chats informative. I know I learned a great deal from our conversations.

Our second goal speaks to the professional development of administrators and staff in support of teaching and learning.

• We continue to engage in a variety of professional learning opportunities. Recently, staff members have participated in ongoing PARCC activities, technology training, peer classroom visits, and demonstrations lessons conducted by our district staff developers.

Our third goal is about communication.

- As you can see, this evening the Board is piloting the use of Schoolboard.net. This program, which was adopted at our last meeting, is intended to help the Board to achieve its 2014-2015 goal to "Go Green". During the transition from a paper agenda and attachments to this paperless platform, we will make a few paper copies available to the public, but we encourage you to access Schoolboard.net from our district website.  Planning for the 2015-2016 budget continues.
