AWARDING OF CONTRACTS FOR SCHOOL ROOF REPLACEMENTS

bids for the Contract B Roof Replacement at Woodside Avenue School Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2022, the Board received seven bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Lakes Board of Education ("Board") advertised for

WHEREAS, the lowest bid for the Project was submitted by Laumar Roofing Co., Inc.

("Laumar") with a base bid in the amount of \$\$1,529,000 with a deduction Alternate No.

1B, in the amount of \$50,000, for a total contract sum of \$1,479,000; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Laumar being responsive in all material respects, the Board, at its November 8, 2022 meeting, resolved to award the Project to Laumar for a total contract sum of \$\$1,529,000 without the Alternate No. 1B; and

WHEREAS, The Board desires to rescind its award of the Project contract and amend the award to include the deduction of Alternate No. 1B in the amount of \$50,000 for a revised total contract sum of \$1,479,000; and

WHEREAS, Laumar remains the lowest bidder for the Project with the inclusion of Alternate 1B.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Board hereby rescinds its award of the Project contract to Laumar in the amount of \$1,524,000 which was approved at its November 8, 2022 meeting.

2. The Board hereby awards an amended Project contract to Laumar, which includes a base bid in the amount of \$1,529,000 with the deduction of Alternate No. 1B for a total contract sum of \$1,479,000.

3. This award is expressly conditioned upon the contractor furnishing the requisite insurance certificate and labor and materials/performance bond as required in the project specifications, together with an AA201-Project Manning Report, an executed A-101-Standard Form of Agreement Between Owner and Contractor, A-201-General Conditions of the Contract for Construction, as prepared by the Board Attorney, within ten (10) days of the date hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board Attorney is hereby directed to draft the agreement with the successful bidder consistent with this Resolution and with the terms contained in the bid documents approved by the Board for the Project.
