**Partner with Wilson Language Training
Wilson Foundations Level K
Franklin Lakes Site Contract**

This contract is entered into as of November 13, 2018 between Ann Robinowitz Education Center (NEWGRANGE, 526 South Olden Avenue, NJ 08629) and Franklin Lakes, located at 490 Pulis Avenue, Franklin Lakes, NJ 07417. By signing this contract, NEWGRANGE and Franklin Lakes agree to the terms and conditions set forth.

On January 8th (with January 15th as snow date), 2019, NEWGRANGE Staff, Susan Miller, M.A., LDT/C will work on a consulting basis and in a collaborative effort with teachers at Franklin Lakes in Wilson Foundations Level K to increase the literacy and overall academic success of their students. This effort will also increase the pedagogy and instructional strategies of the teachers involved in the project so that they will understand current research about improving literacy. Further, they will be able to use diagnostic and prescriptive teaching methods to most effectively enhance the skills of their students, thereby increasing academic success. Ultimate results depend also on the skills, efforts and availability of Franklin Lakes staff.

WILSON FOUNDATIONS LEVEL K

Foundations Level K focuses on letter formation, print knowledge, alphabetic awareness, and phonological and phonemic awareness training. In Level K training, teachers begin to learn how to instruct their students to:

- Read and spell approximately 200 CVC words
- Write manuscript letters in lower- and upper-case associated with sounds
- Understand concepts of print
- Identify separate words in an oral sentence, segment words into syllables, and segment syllables into sounds (phonemes) – up to 3 sounds
- Know alphabetic order and a-z letter/sound relationships (map letter to sound and sound to letter)
- Retell short narrative stories and echo-read a passage with phrasing and expression

Franklin Lakes agrees to pay \$2500/per day for 1 day, plus travel expenses, totaling \$2500 plus travel. Travel expenses including mileage, food, accommodations (if necessary) and other reasonable incidentals will be billed accordingly. A proforma invoice accompanies this contract and Franklin Lakes will provide NEWGRANGE with a Voucher/Purchase Order Number, which must be received 30 days prior to the training date, along with this signed Site Contract.

Re-scheduling: Should there be a need to reschedule, 1 week advanced notice is required. It is expected that new dates for consultation will be chosen at a date mutually acceptable to both parties.
