- Oversee and moderate summer Algebra/Geometry classes
- Grade FAMS Math course placement tests
- Research and develop opportunities to integrate Financial Literacy in Grades 6 & 7 math courses, as per new NJSLS requirement (As signed into law, A-1414/S-1592 (P.L.2018, c.167) directs the State Board of Education to require school districts to incorporate financial literacy instruction into the curriculum for students enrolled in sixth through eighth grade. This requirement will go into effect at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year.
