This letter is in reference to the Division of Food and Nutrition's review of your Auditor's report of the School Food Service operations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.

Our review of the auditor's report indicates the following food service findings:

<u>Finding:</u> A review of the Food Service account indicates the cash level exceeds three times the average expenditures.

Recommendation: Steps should be taken to reduce the excess food service account balance by taking steps to improve food quality or consider replacing and improving food equipment.

Finding: No report was provided regarding the separate recording of food, labor and other cost. In addition, there was no reporting of inventory records on food and supply items and whther than were properly applied

Recommendations: The finding items noted are required to be reviewed and reported during the audit process.
