WHEREAS, the Board is currently contesting Gaeta's action and is seeking recourse to the Bid Bond issued to the Board on behalf of Gaeta guaranteeing its performance of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Board is required to re-advertise the contract for the Services regardless of any recourse it is pursuing against Gaeta; and

WHEREAS, pending the result of the re-advertisement for the Services, Gaeta has agreed these services to the Board on an emergency basis without prejudice to either party's position on the contract dispute; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the emergency contract including price, duration and the parties' respective rights and responsibilities are set forth in the proposed Agreement, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the emergency contract with Gaeta which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Board President and the Business Administrator/Board Secretary are hereby authorized to execute such agreement and any other documents necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution.
